Winter League Rules

Why Play 2 man Winter League

- **Hi all you keen tennis players,**
- This league was established in response to those players who wish to play singles over the winter and want to play Configure ranking matches. This initiative will also help funds for the continued renovation of Mitchell Park. It is planned to compliment winter sports activities as much as possible, and avoid conflict with the existing Frampton Regional Winter Interclub and school holidays.
 1. The format will be teams of minimum of 2 (reserves are allowed but cannot play for 2 different teams in the same round) substitution of players is allowed within the team, but not after a match has started.
 2. Tennis NZ rules apply.
 3. One doubles and then each of the players will play their singles, In teams with more than 2 players different players can play doubles and singles. Players to play singles in ranking order on date of play according to S grade.
 4. Draws will depend on entries and will be circulated and posted on the HVTA website under draws and results sheets under forms. This link will be created once the draw has been made and Teams will be sent web link.
 5. The teams will be ranked by the highest top dog singles ranking from each team, rather than a combined ranking.
 6. Depending on the number of teams entered the divisions will be established, the target is 8 teams in each division.
 7. There will be 7 matches across the winter season, no matches will be scheduled for the school holiday period. The winner of the cup is the top team in Div 1.
 8. **PLAYING DATES** as per Fact Sheet.
 9. Teams to confirm with each other by Thursday night before play. On the day, in the event of rain, the home team to decide and communicate with visiting team if a match should be called off. Rained off matches can either be rescheduled if both teams agree or award points 1 each.
 10. Teams to supply balls - each team to supply 2 new Tecnifibre X-one balls for each round. Good prices from HVT pro shop.
 11. Refer disputes to the Winter league committee – Ian Miller and Andrew Chuah
 12. **Results** – 1 point per match Results are required to be put promptly into **Configure rankings** by the winning team.
